Horses/ponies may only compete in **one** race. Horses/ponies must be paraded in the Paddock before their race.

Dogs on leads please.

To avoid endangering other competitors as well as your self please ensure that you and your horse are fit enough and that your tack and equipment are suitable for the event. (Think Team Chase/cross country **not Point to Point**)

Vet/Farrier fees incurred at the event are the responsibility of the competitor and owner. It is at the discretion of the professional supplying the service as to whether or not fees are payable at the time of treatment.

All riders **must** wear riding hats to the following standards PAS 015/ BSEN 1384/ASTM F1163 and back protectors BETA Level 3.

## Liability

Neither the organising committee nor any of the sponsors shall be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury however caused to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Moreover by entering, every participant accepts this disclaimer and warrants the suitability of the entered horse/pony and rider to take part. Ponies 14.2 hh and under – riders 15 yrs and under on day of event. 2 laps over a course of fences approximately 2' height. Distance 3/4 mile approx.

2 12.40 pm **PUFFED OUT BILLY STAKES**

Fences approximately 2' (Puffing Billy Course). Open to all. Distance 3/4 mile approx. The **Fairfields Farm Riding Stables Cup** to the winner. A Cup will be awarded to the highest placed cob in the race and rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> for the cobs sponsored by **SPJ Improvements**. A Shield to be awarded to the highest placed Registered Native Pony. Race sponsored by **EMERSONWILLIS**

1.15 pm **PARADE OF FOXHOUNDS and opportunity to meet hounds in the parade ring**

3 1.45 pm **ASHEY SCURRY**

Fences approximately 2'6". Distance approx. 2 miles. The **Claire Hicks Memorial Cup** to the winner. **Trumor Feeds Shield** to highest placed pony 14.2 and under. Race sponsored by **LESLIES MOTORS &**

4 2.25 pm **JUNIOR SCURRY**

Open to riders aged 16 and under on day of the event. Fences approximately 2'6". Distance approx. 2 miles. The **Fairfields Farm Honour Bound Cup to the winner**. Race sponsored by **WESTRIDGE GARAGE**

5. 3.05 pm **BCM ISLE OF WIGHT GRAND NATIONAL**

Open to riders 16 and over on date of event. Two laps of the Grand National course. Fence heights vary up to approximately 4'. Distance approximately 2.2 miles. The **Blackgang Chine Cup** to the winner. The **Diamond Isle Sculptured Glass Trophy** to the highest placed Isle of Wight horse. Race sponsored by **BCM**

The **Havenstreet Cup** awarded to the Highest Placed Heavyweight horse in any class (to be nominated on day of event)

**Turnout award** – A special rosette and prize will be awarded to the best turned out horse/pony in each division.

The **David Biles Memorial Commentators' Cup** will be awarded at the discretion of the Commentators over the course of the day.

**Special Rosettes will also be awarded in each division to:**

First horse/pony regularly hunted with IW Foxhounds this season

The first horse/pony ridden by an IW Pony Club member

**Entry Fee - £15 per class**

**Closing Date – Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2020**

**All trophies must be returned by 15<sup>th</sup> March 2020 to the secretary.**

A deposit of £20 will be required from winners that do not reside on the Isle of Wight

**LATE ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMITTEE. FEE £20.**

**ENTRIES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE CORRECT ENTRY FEE AND SAE FOR PASSES**

**A DEPOSIT OF £5 WILL BE CHARGED PER NUMBER CLOTH. PLEASE BRING CORRECT MONEY**

**SAFETY LIMITS APPLY IN ALL CLASSES AND THEY WILL BE DIVIDED OR MERGED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMITTEE. COURSE LENGTHS MAY BE ADJUSTED FROM THOSE STATED TO SUIT PREVAILING CONDITIONS ON THE DAY. ANY COMPETITOR WHO FALLS CANNOT CONTINUE OR RIDE IN ANOTHER CLASS UNTIL DECLARED FIT TO DO SO BY THE ON SITE PARAMEDIC.**

**Declarations**

All competitors are required to declare their intention to compete no later than 11.15am on the day. In cases of emergency or for competitors travelling from the mainland declarations may be made to the Secretary by telephone 07970 692240. Failure to declare by the specified time will result in exclusion from that class and forfeit of entry fee.
