Horses/ponies may only compete in **one** class but may also participate in the Parade of Hounds

Horses/ponies must be paraded in the Paddock before their race.

Dogs on leads please.

To avoid endangering other competitors as well as your self please ensure that you and your horse are fit enough and that your tack and equipment are suitable for the event. (Think Team Chase/cross country **not Point to Point**)

Vet/Farrier fees incurred at the event are the responsibility of the competitor and owner. It is at the discretion of the professional supplying the service as to whether or not fees are payable at the time of treatment.

All riders **must** wear riding hats to the following standards PAS 015/ BSEN 1384/ASTM F1163 and back protectors BETA Level 3.

Liability

Neither the organising committee nor any of the sponsors shall be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury however caused to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Moreover by entering, every participant accepts this disclaimer and warrants the suitability of the entered horse/pony and rider to take part.
